The dining area is large enough to seat up to 40 people comfortably and also has tea and coffee making facilities for you to use at any time.



The chalet offers a large sunny and comfy lounge with squashy sofas, plenty of books and games and wonderful views down the valley towards La Tournette mountain. The separate TV/DVD room with SKY is popular after a hard day's skiing and provides another area in which to relax and unwind.



If you're feeling a little more lively after the day of fresh air then our fully stocked bar is the place for you. We have Kronenbourg and Guinness on tap plus a wide selection of bottled beers, wines and spirits including a range of Scottish single malt whiskies.

The bar is equipped with a table football and other bar games as well as having 2 flat-screen TV's with SKY for the big sports matches that just can't be missed! For your convenience we operate a tab-system for our guests meaning you can simply settle up for all of your extra spend (bar, equipment hire, ski lessons etc) at the end of your stay.



The bedrooms are located on the 1st and 2nd floors and we have a range of double or twin rooms plus four larger family rooms. Most of our rooms can be made as either double or twin rooms giving ultimate flexibility to accommodate your group's requirements. Some of the bedrooms have access onto the terrace whilst they all benefit from stunning mountain views



All of the rooms are en-suite with shower and WC and are made up with duvets. In addition we supply all towels and a selection of complimentary toiletries.

If your party contains children or babies then we have a number of cots, high chairs and specialist equipment. We have a playroom for children containing books, games, toys and a place to chill out away from the adults, as well as a Nintendo games console for those big kids amongst you! There is access to our sun terrace through the playroom too.
