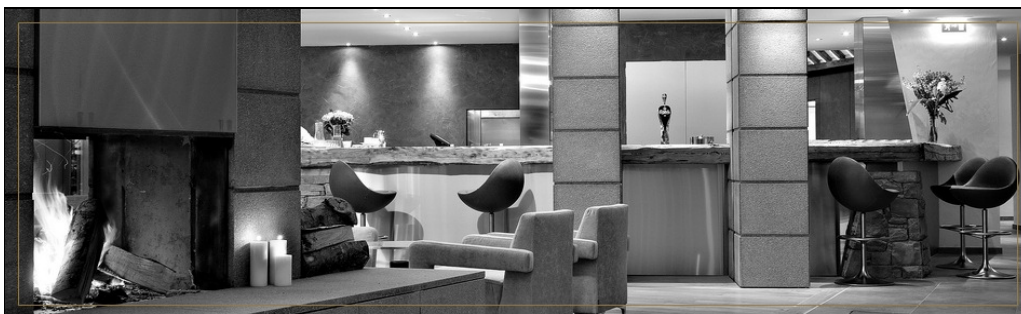


The premium hotel in La Clusaz offers 5-star facilities and a very high level of service. Below is a brief run-down of the main hotel facilities and a picture tour of the main features that will contribute to the overall experience of your 5-star stay in the heart of La Clusaz.

The hotel is located in the heart of the village centre in La Clusaz, just set back from the main square and church and a very quick walk to all the shops, bars and restaurants which are literally on your doorstep  
You enter the hotel with its large and spacious bar/lounge area with an attractive central fireplace and this space doubles as a great informal meeting space and break-out zone for any work meetings.



Whilst waiting for your colleagues, why not settle into one of the comfy chairs, enjoy the open log-burning fire and enjoy a drink from the cocktail bar? The bar is a sleek contemporary design and a great central sociable place to enjoy an aperitif at the end of a hard day spent working, skiing or undertaking any of the summer activities.



The hotel features 50 suites, junior suites and bedrooms and they are all beautifully decorated in a blend of old wood and contemporary mountain style with high quality fittings and equipment and luxury soft furnishings.



Junior suites (32/42m<sup>2</sup>) sleep up to 3 and have a king-size bed or 2 single beds, a lounge with single divan bed, satellite TV, telephone, private safe, mini-bar (soft drinks included), wireless internet access, feature fire and a balcony offering great views towards the mountain or the village, an en-suite bathroom with Jacuzzi bath and hairdryer, separate wc.



Privilege suites(46/50m2) sleeping up to 4 and Family suites(62/80m2) for up to 5 guests have an additional shower room and wc and are available at a supplement.

Whichever room or suite option you choose you will enjoy the modern high quality fittings with tasteful design and due to the hotel being only a few months old everything is fresh and in immaculate condition.

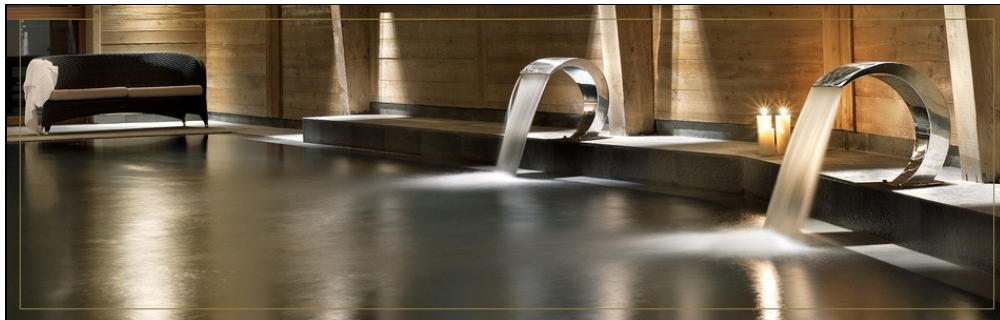


There is a strong emphasis on high quality food at this hotel and the chef has come direct from a Michelin starred restaurant and this recognition is surely on the agenda for this hotel. The restaurant offers a refined cuisine based on organic locally sourced produce.



The buffet breakfast offers a comprehensive range of bread and pastries, juices, fruit, eggs, bacon, cereals, yogurts etc. Dinner is a great experience and the glass screen to the open plan kitchen allows you to watch the care and attention going into your freshly prepared meal.

The hotel also benefits from an extensive and purpose built spa complex which offers a wide range of relaxing leisure facilities as well as a full treatment selection. Again – this whole facility was newly built just a few months ago and designed with care and attention to detail.



The Spa includes an indoor heated swimming pool, Jacuzzi, steam room, sauna and 5 private treatment rooms offering beauty treatments, revitalising massages and cleansing body scrubs which are perfect for a treat.



The hotel has been developed for both the leisure and corporate market and as well as offering a restful haven for holidays and mountain breaks, it also features some well equipped and practical meeting rooms.



These seminar and meeting rooms can be booked for the duration of your stay or just for certain events and meetings. The size of rooms can be varied with sliding walls and screens and they offer a flexible solution that meets most groups needs within your own hotel.

If you require something a little different then the local villages are able to offer a wide range of purpose built function rooms and can offer the full range from small seminar rooms up to a full conference centre with theatre seating for up to 800 people in the neighbouring village of Grand Bornand.



In its brief history this hotel has already hosted a regional economic forum attended by President Sarkozy and the hotel operating group are very well experienced in hosting prestigious events and receptions across their 3 other hotels within the region.
